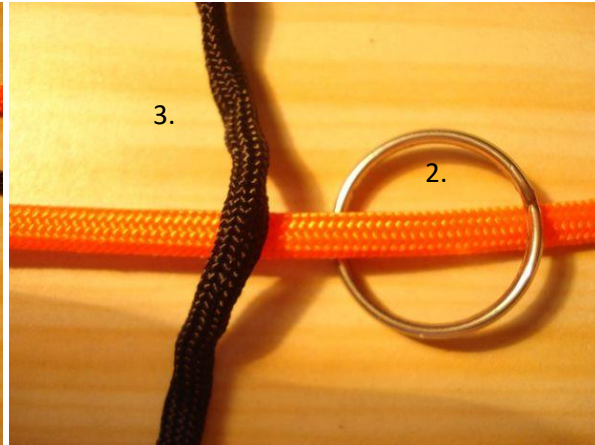
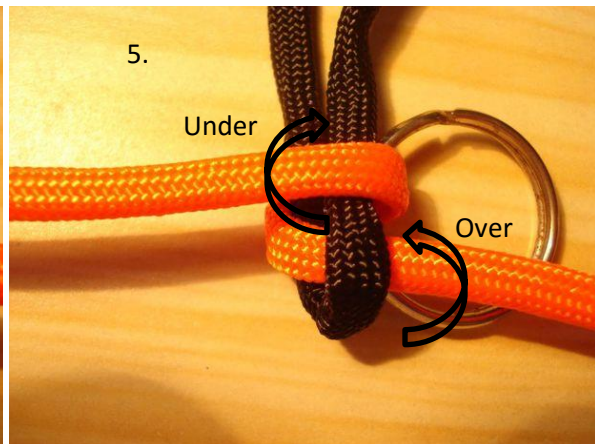


Keychain – Square Braid

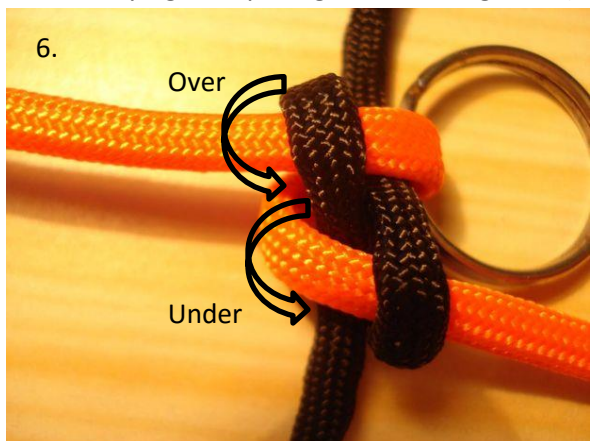
1. Start with 2 pieces of paracord of the same length (2-4ft) and a keyring
2. Place the keyring on one piece (orange) and slide it to the center (easiest way to find center is by folding the piece in half).
3. Find the center of the 2nd piece and place its center on the center of the 1st.



4. Starting with the “under” piece (orange), cross the ends over the other (black) piece
5. Use an “over” then “under” pattern to weave the 2nd piece. Note: The “over” side initially stays on the side with closer end.

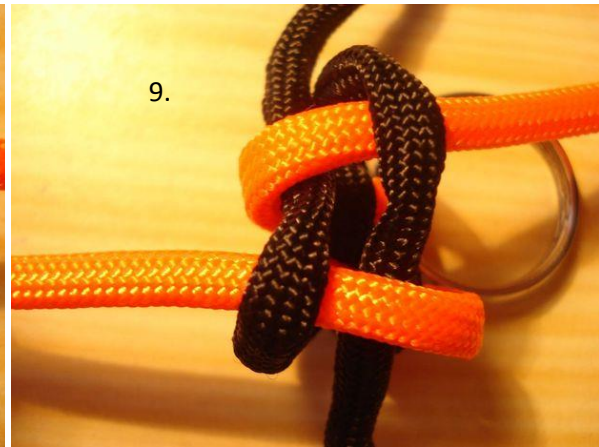
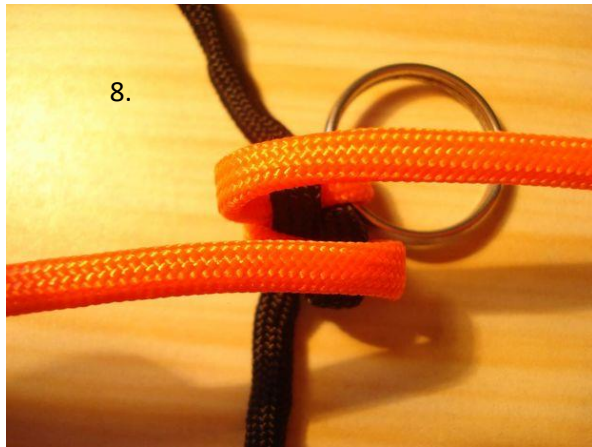


6. Repeat with the other end of the 2nd piece, using the “over” and “under” pattern.
7. Carefully tighten, pulling all 4 ends together (out-wards).



8. Start the next braid by crossing the orange pieces (keep the cord on the same side)

9. Weave the black cord over-under to complete the braid.



10. Continue adding braids until the desired length is achieved (or you run out of rope). Cut and Melt the ends.
